### **RETREAT CONTENT:**

At this Central Regional retreat, we take The 'Bridging Project' into the realm of 'Speaking with the Stars'. In the life between death and re-birth the human being is engaged in an intimate conversation with the 'Stars'. We will prepare for, view and work to hold the light during the 'Great American Solar Eclipse', which will sweep from West to East across all of America, and will be visible in the St. Louis area on Monday August 21st 2017. Through the social arts of folk-eurythmy, song, study, color, meditation, and an interactive pageant, we will engage with the spiritual significance of this powerful cosmic and earthly event. Afterward we will process, share and continue the conversation, working to understand the mysteries of the will.

#### **RETREAT LOCATION:**
