During this conference we will focus on the qualities and spiritual aspects of our personal destiny when we take the path of the 19 Class Lessons. Different perspectives on destiny will appear from the moment we take the decision to enter this path to the different situations as they evolve in the course of the Lessons. The meeting with the Guardian of the Threshold brings us to a recognition of the deeper realities that surround us, which challenge us to take the inner initiative to develop balancing forces within our soul. Each new outer challenge calls for a stronger inner response.

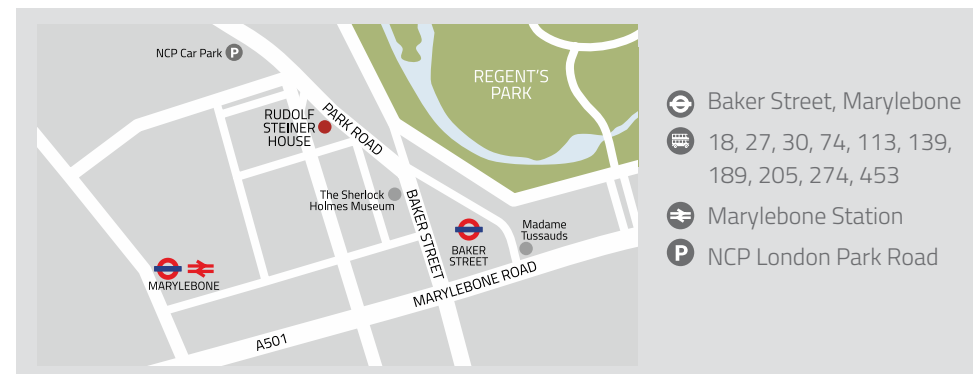

Looking at the path of the Michael School from this perspective a deep connection to our human biography becomes visible, as well as the potential for the development of new qualities of awareness, discernment and responsibility. Thus, through the call to "Know Yourself" we learn to face our own being and become more fully responsible for our ongoing development.

The strong influence of time on our destiny causes us to become increasingly responsible for the interpenetration of past and future as we stand in the present. Looking at the specific qualities of our thinking, feeling and willing we can discover how they have developed in us out of the past. Through the guidance of the Guardian, we can learn to reconstitute and integrate these three soul forces anew. Reworking our past habits and capacities awakens us to our individual potential.

This five-day immersive journey through the entirety of the 19 Lessons enables this process and opens up new perspectives on destiny as an essential aspect of the human journey.
