In this course we will explore an entirely new approach to color, useful for the experienced or inexperienced painter, the teacher, as well as the therapist. Through exploring watercolor painting in this manner, balance and harmony in the "color conversation" unfold. The result for the painter is a sense of well-being, as well as satisfying artistic creation.

This course runs concurrent with that offered for Waldorf teachers.
