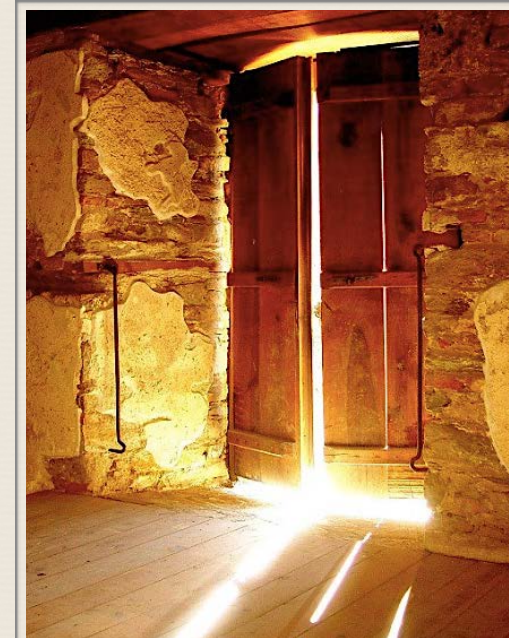

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What is **Biography** work, this new approach to human life, which is being developed more and more around the world? Rather than merely focusing on the details of an individual life, it expands our human perspective to include an exploration of the larger world in which we live.

Learning to read one's Biography, 'life-writing,' as the word suggests, encourages an appreciation for the cosmic rhythms that sustain life. Discovering the growth process of a rose or drawing the seasons of a tree can bring a sense of order and lawfulness as we look at human life. Biography work takes us into the complexities of human becoming and can shed light on questions of meaning.

Learning to trust process while lessening the focus on product, encourages a sense of play, risk and adventure.

Between sessions, participants are reading, observing, keeping a journal and working on individual projects.

Social Art describes a way of working in which discoveries and insights are enhanced by entering artistically with others into the exploration of a theme.

This professional development program provides a laboratory for adult learning in which participants are trained through their own activity.

We engage in discovery through: the art of conversation, writing, singing, nature observation, painting & drawing, spacial dynamics and clay modeling.
