RETREAT CONTENT:

This Central Regional retreat will be the culmination of the 'Bridging Project: Between Life and Death from Soul to Soul'. You are warmly invited to join others from the region and the local community in a gathering to artistically experience, in time and space, the journey of the soul through the cycle of life and after-death, as indicated from the spiritual research of Rudolf Steiner. We will each have a chance to walk the pathway of our beloved across the threshold, being present for them, as well as preparing for our own journey.

You can join others in creating the festival over the whole weekend, or just come to the festival on Saturday evening (registration not required for Saturday evening only, suggested donation \$10).

Friday evening will include a ceremony honoring our beloved who have died. The weekend will deepen this focus of the soul's journey and connecting across the threshold with artistic experiences including color exercises, eurythmy with Mary Ruud, singing and lyre music. We will also have discussions around the bridging theme and the study, *The Influence of the Dead on Destiny* by Rudolf Steiner.
